



MATERIALS YOU NEED TO INSTALL A GLASS TILE BACKSPLASH

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- Chalk box
- Level
- L Square
- Tape Measure
- Trough
- Straight edge scraper
- Diamond Blade Wet Saw
- Bucket
- Mixing paddle (for cement)
- Electric Drill (not cordless)
- Sharpie
- Rubber Malet
- tooth pick
- Tiling Bucket with Supplies*
- Damp Disposable Clothe
- Utility Knife
- Cutting Surface

6 TIPS TO FOLLOW :

1. When cutting glass tile, wear a long sleeve shirt and safety glasses. Glass fragments hurt!!!
2. Clean up while you do each step. It saves you time at the end.
3. Grab a friend to help you with this project. When placing 10X10 sheet of tile on a wall, an extra set of hands is helpful.
4. Keep your tools in one place. Use the sink area as command central to keep the tools clean and organized.
5. After you apply the mortar or adhesive on the 10X10 glass tile, go back and check to make sure that the bottom doesn't protrude or stick out from the rest due to the weight.
6. Use a toothpick to get excess mortar out from between the tiles after you have the glass tiles in place. This allows for room to apply grout.

TIMEFRAME:

Day 1: 3-4 Hours but can vary for square footage.
Day 2: Follow the directions for the mortar to set completely before finishing with grout and sealer.

NOTES:

Buy 20% extra of the glass tile you are installing. If you don't use it, it can always be returned or used for different projects. You can also save on buying tools if you use premix mortar and grout. These items cost more initially but you save time and money if you don't already own an electric drill and mixing paddle.
